Over View:

Hanoi is a sacred land of Vietnam. The year 1010 then became an historical date for Hanoi and for the whole country in general. Throughout the thousand years of its eventful history, marked by destruction, wars and natural calamities, Hanoi still preserves many ancient architectural works including the Old Quarter and over 600 pagodas and temples. Famous sites include the One Pillar Pagoda (built in 1049), the Temple of Literature (built in 1070), Hanoi Opera House, President Ho Chi Minh's Mausoleum, The Imperial Citadel of Thăng Long, Vienam History Museum...

Itinerary detail:	
8h00	Our guide will meet you at hotel lobby early in the morning for an interesting historical tour of Hanoi capital.
8h30	Start our tour with the visit to <i>The Imperial Citadel of Thăng Long</i> is a complex of historic imperial buildings located in the centre of Hanoi, Vietnam. The Thang Long Imperial Citadel was built in the 11th century by the Vietnamese Ly Dynasty, marking the independence of the Đại Việt. This UNESCO-listed Heritage Site is a destination you should not miss while staying in Vietnam. The interesting excavated items and mock-ups of the

	citadel will certainly give you a better understanding into Vietnamese cultures and history through thousands of years.
10h00	Visit to <i>Vietnam History Museum</i> – the museum was built in 1926 under the name Louis Finot Museum by the Ecole Française d'Extreme-Orient and finish in 1932. The Vietnam National Museum of History stores and preserves about 200,000 objects and materials of Vietnamese cultural history. Visit the museum, visitors will experience outstanding representations about the history and culture of Vietnam as well as the heroic tradition of the Vietnamese people that was formed during the process of constructing and defending the country.
11h30	Enjoy your lunch with "Cha Ca – La Vong" or Vietnamese traditional food.
13h30	Return to your hotel. End of tour.
